What: New Fan Efficiency ratings in 90.1 and IECC

This presentation will focus on recent fan-related changes to ASHRAE 90.1 and the IECC. Most notably, we will highlight the Fan Energy Index (FEI), the fan efficiency metric included in the most recent version of ASHRAE 90.1 and the IECC. We will provide a description of the technical aspects of the metric, information needed for proper fan selection in commercial and industrial applications, and briefly explain its inclusion in other codes and standards.
